About Maths Week

- Maths Week 2025 is being held from Monday 11 August – Friday 15 August.
- Maths Week provides resources to support the mathematics and statistics curriculum. The resources are free to all New Zealand schools.
- Maths Week has been held every year since 1998.
- Maths Week is an NZAMT event, and is supported by the Ministry of Education.
- The aims of Maths Week are:
 - to encourage students' interest in mathematics and statistics
 - to give teachers resources that they can use in the classroom, particularly material that requires some research and which may not be readily available to them, or that can be used electronically in class
 - to show the pleasure that mathematics can provide and some of the everyday places where it can be used
 - to give teachers material that can provide extension.
- Last year, 5269 teachers and 242 400 students registered.

Maths Week materials can be easily accessed on computers, lap-tops, tablets, and SMART phones, either at school or at home. Some of the activities are interactive.

Maths Week is written to include all students from Year 1 to Year 11. Several levels of ability at each year level catered for.

Teachers who register get the answers to questions (and additional notes where these may be helpful).
